



Champion Development Seminar

The Champion Development Seminar will be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of U.S. Figure Skating. This seminar is open to all eligible members, as defined by the Eligibility Rules, and currently registered members of a U.S. Figure Skating member club, a collegiate club, or an individual member in accordance with the current Rulebook. Refer to the current rulebook regarding eligibility of non-US citizens.

Eligibility Requirements: Skaters must be able to perform a waltz jump, salchow, toe loop, and beginning back spin.

Entry deadline: Must be received by April 1, 2023

Refund Policy: Entry fees will not be refunded after the entry deadline unless there is a written doctor's excuse, or the seminar is cancelled. Online processing fees are non-refundable.
